

Programs to serve Clarington's Children

Traditional Program & Couples Match

Our "Bigs" are doing BIG things with their "Littles" as they meet together on a regular basis for a couple of hours each week. Children who spend time with a mentor gain confidence, acquire new skills and competencies and learn the importance of showing care for others. Mentors experience a sense of discovery and enjoyment as they experience the world through a child's eyes.





In-School Mentoring Program

An hour a week is all it takes to make a huge difference in a child's live. Our in-school mentors get the chance to feel like a kid again as they meet with their mentee to play games, bake something delicious or pass a soccer ball back an forth. It is time well spent building a child's confidence, sharing a laugh and learning something new.

Go Girls! Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds / Game On!

Go Girls! Healthy Bodies, Healthy Minds and Game On! are group based mentoring programs run by volunteer mentors. Through non-traditional physical activity the programs are designed to provide girls/boys, aged 12-14 with the information and support they need to make informed choices about healthy, active living.

Big Bunch

A once-a- month group mentoring program that is designed for children on the waiting list waiting to be matched with their very own big brother or sister. Volunteers get together with groups of waiting children, and take part in fun activities from fishing derby's and pool parties to holiday celebrations and movie nights.

After School Program

The after school program takes place once a week in 5 different locations and was established to provide children a safe and supervised environment to engage in recreational/sports activities. In this program children develop physical literacy and social skills as they interact with other children and mentors. This program keeps children/youth engaged in constructive activities during a time when they are most likely to get into trouble.

Champions of Change Summer Camp

This program provides a wide range of summer experiences for children aged 6-8 and 9-13. Each of our 7 themed weeks provides a combination of cooperative games, sports, crafts and leadership activities. Children have fund while developing important leadership qualities.
