

DONATION DRIVE

From April to the end of July, we collected close to **8,000 lbs.** of donated items. That's equivalent to the weight of two SUVs!



Over the past few months, several individuals in our community generously donated items (clothing, linens, housewares, etc.) to our Donation Drive.

Last Thursday, BBBSC staff and camp staff successfully loaded and delivered close to **8,000 lbs.** of donated items to Value Village in Whitby. Value Village runs a great program where they pay not-for-profits for each pound of collected goods.

The 8,000 lbs. of items collected, resulted in close to **\$1,050.00!** That money will go directly towards helping to ignite the power and potential of the close to 500 children we serve in our community.

We would like to give a big shoutout to everyone that helped make this event possible!
